#### Welcome to the Airedale Field Nationals

The Airedale came to America shortly after its development in England in the last half of the 19th century. In the first part of the 20th century, Americans' appreciation of the Airedale's hunting heritage was summarized in 1916 by Warren H. Miller (longtime editor of Field and Stream) in his classic book *The American Hunting Dog*. "On the borderline between the bird dog and the fur dog stands the Airedale," Miller wrote, "...the dog that can hunt both ... and the one who can and is being successfully trained to hunt everything alive that can be hunted."

The Airedale enjoyed widespread popularity in America at the start of the 20th century. In addition to its hunting abilities, the breed's reputation built on its fame as a war dog in WWI, and it's exploits as a big game hunter in the American West. Over time, demographics and society changed, and Airedale popularity shifted to a much smaller fan base who maintained the breed mainly as companions and home protectors.

One of the goals of the founders of this club back in 1985 was to have the Airedale Terrier once again recognized as a versatile hunting dog by the wider sporting dog world. Finally, in 2009 the American Kennel Club allowed Airedales to enter AKC Upland (Spaniel) Hunt Tests. Since February, 2018, the AKC has allowed ATCA Fur Test titles to be recorded on AKC pedigrees and certificates. And starting in 2019 Airedales were allowed to run in AKC Retriever Hunt Tests. None of this could have been accomplished without the work of the Airedale Terrier Club of America's Hunting and Field Committee, who carried our breed's requests for AKC hunt test participation to the AKC.

Now that Airedales are allowed in AKC Hunt Tests, special credit goes to the owner/handlers who have trained their Airedales as competitive as the traditional sporting breeds. Since 2009 over two dozen Airedales have earned AKC Hunt Test titles, including several Master Hunters. Post-pandemic, several Airedales have qualified in AKC Retriever tests. The vast majority of Airedale entrants in AKC tests got their start and/or participated in HWA events. HWA events are both a training ground and a launch pad for continuing field work.

So whether you have ambitions involving hunt tests or whether you just want to get out in the field with your dog, thank you for being part of the hunting Airedale community.

No whips, prong collars, or abuse of dogs will be tolerated. Entrants found using such devices or observed abusing their dog may be dismissed with no refund of entry fees.

### **Important Notes**

### Tests, Schedule and Entry Fees

Each hunt test will be offered at Junior, Senior, and Master levels. Flushing and Retriever entry fees at all levels are \$65.00 per test. Fur entry fees are \$30 at all levels payable to the ATCA with entry sent via the ATCA Fur Test Premium.

### **Courses and Birds**

Chukar or pheasant will be used for all land tests. Ducks, chukar or pheasant will be used in the Retriever Test water series.

#### **Prizes**

Rosettes and certificates will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score at a previously unearned level.

#### Refunds, Scratches, No Shows

Bitches in season shall not be permitted on the grounds. Entry fees paid for a bitch withdrawn because of coming into season or for a dog withdrawn because of an injury or illness, or for a dog which dies, shall be refunded in full by the test-giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate. Requests and documentation must be presented prior to the test. There will be no refunds for "no shows". Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from the test by action of the test-giving club. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the test-giving club.

### **Fur and Retriever**

### Jim Middaugh

Jim grew up in Chicago's inner city and didn't get his first dog until he got married and bought his first house. He knew he wanted a goodsized dog that had a lot of grit and would be a good tough watchdog. He also always dreamed of having a hunting dog of some kind. But what breed? He was came across a 99-cent book with these totally different looking goodsize dogs on the cover. That book told Jim the story of Jack, an Airedale sentry dog in World War I, who gave his life to deliver a message to soldiers in a foxhole before dropping dead having traveled miles on a broken leg.

The Airedale's heroism and bravery inspired Jim to fall in love with the breed. Eventually he discovered the early Hunting/Working Airedale group, and he supported their efforts to restore the Airedale to the great hunting dog role they were originally bred for. Jim first attended the Hunting Working Airedale Nationals in 1994. He was an H/W Committee member for many years. He also served as chairman for the Cooley Hunt Test every May in Wisconsin for 12 years before passing the torch.

Jim's first two Airedales were both great fur-hunting dogs. His second Airedale acquired the Master Fur Hunting Title, qualified in the Master test three straight years, and always was the highest scoring dog in the Fur Tests . His third Airedale, named Jack after the famous war hero, acquired his Master Fur title and then attained a Senior Upland & Senior Retriever title.

Today Jim owns his third Labrador Retriever. His first Labrador attained an AKC Senior Hunter Retriever title. His current Labrador is in training for AKC Retriever tests with the goal of attaining an AKC Master Retriever title.

Jim and his wife are planning to get another Airedale in the future, as the breed is in their hearts and souls. Jim is thrilled to attend and be a judge at this year's HWA Nationals this year.


